Reading Group Guide

Discussion Questions

- 1. What are some dreams that you have? How do you work to achieve those goals?
- 2. In *The Dream Keepers*, there are Happy Thoughts and Hard Work. How do each of these help make your dreams come true?
 - a. Why is it important to not only Work Hard, but think positively about the work you are doing?
- 3. How can you make sure you don't lose your Happy Thoughts while you work to make your dreams a reality?
- 4. Have you experienced your Happy Thoughts being taken in the wrong direction? How can you regain your focus when this happens?
- 5. The Dream Keepers mentions to celebrate progress that you have made. Can you think of ways that you can celebrate the steps you take to make a dream come true?
 - a. Why is it important to appreciate progress, not just the final product?
- 6. Are there any goals that you are proud of achieving?
 - a. How did you feel once you accomplished that dream?
 - b. Imagine how it may feel to accomplish your next big dream!

Extension Activities

- 1. Have students draw their own Dream Keepers and a goal that they want to become reality. Talk about what has inspired them to be interested in these goals and why they want to work to make their dream come true.
- 2. Pass out stars that students can write their dreams on. Collect and display their stars on a board and speak about how the group can support each other in their dreams and work.
